Instructions:

1. Open your group each week with some kind of get-to-know-you question.
2. Show the video (between 5-15 minutes) that will intro the topic. Can ask group what they heard, or what they had questions about from the video.
3. Go through the key sections of the Workbook. Remember to prioritize what you want to talk about since you might not get through it all.
4. Homework:
 - A. The first two chapters of the curriculum have no Bible readings to go with them, so you can assign people to read the curriculum outside of group time and come ready to discuss what they read.
 - B. From week #3 on there is a 66 day reading schedule of scripture readings, and this should be the homework for the group. Work through the group curriculum during your time together, and don't assign them any reading from the workbook.
 - C. Do encourage people to not worry about getting behind on the readings. If they miss a day, no big deal just leave it and read the day they are on. Better to have read most than to hung-up on a couple missed days.
5. Don't forget to spend time in prayer together each time you meet.
